their 20th anniversary, Boyz II Men still holds the No. 1, 3 and 4 spots for still holds the No. 1, 3 and 4 spots for the longest running No. 1 singles in Billboard history. The group's first No. 1 single, 1992's "End of the Road," stayed atop the Billboard Hot 100 for 13 weeks, breaking a decades-old record held by Elvis Presley. The hits "I'll Make Love to You" and "One Sweet Day" set new records at 14 and 16 weeks.
