LMC men rally for victory over Ancilla

The Lake Michigan College men's basketball team trailed for most of the game, but led when it counted against Ancilla College on Saturday.

With the Red Hawks trailing by a point, Terrell Clinton found Loren Johnson for a layup and he was fouled. Johnson hit the free throw to give LMC a 70-68 win.

Ken Coates led a balanced Red Hawk scoring attack with 17 points. Terrell Clinton had 14 points, and Johnson and Alec Brown added 10 points each.

LMC women win 13th straight game

The Lake Michigan College women's basketball team pushed its winning streak to 13 games with an impressive 90-49 win over Ancilla College on Saturday.

The Red Hawks (11-0 MCAA West, 20-3), ranked 11th in the nation,

controlled the game from the start, leading 49-24 at the half.

Nicole Decker led LMC with 21 points and nine rebounds. DeYahnna Styles was solid at the point, scoring 12 points and handing out 11 assists.

Sabrina Trujillo added 17 points and Kaitelyn Smith had 14 points.

Cubs agree to 1-year deal with Samardzija

CHICAGO (AP) — The Chicago Cubs and starting pitcher Jeff Samardzija have agreed to a one-year, \$5,345,000 contract, avoiding arbitration.

The deal announced Saturday leaves the Cubs with no remaining players in arbitration.

Samardzija asked for \$6.2 million and was offered \$2,765,000 after going 8-13 with a 4.34 ERA last year, when he made \$2,765,000. The 29-year-old right-hander could be a candidate to be traded after he and the team were unable to come to terms on a long-term contract.
