LMC men reach regional final

SAGINAW — Lake Michigan College's men's basketball team advanced to the National Junior College Athletic Association's District 9 regional championship game with a 71-52 victory over Glen Oaks Community College on Thursday night.

Ken Coates had 22 points and seven rebounds for the Red Hawks (19-12), who will face Lansing Community College at 11 a.m. Saturday at Delta College in Saginaw for the regional title.

"I'm hoping we've got another good one in us," said LMC coach Doug Schaffer. "We have a lot of sophomores on this team, and we've put ourselves in a good position come tournament time."

Terrell Clinton had a solid all-around game for the Red Hawks with four points, seven rebounds, four assists and four steals.

"Clinton's floor game — from the four-spot on the floor — was incredible," Schaffer said.

Glen Oaks (22-7), the top seed in the regional, also was champion of the Michigan Community College Athletic Association's Western Conference.

"Both our games against Glen Oaks were one-possession games," Schaffer said. "Tonight our defense was as good as it gets."

Schaffer said LMC split a pair of close games this season against Lansing.
