

Electronics recycling event set in SH

SOUTH HAVEN — Area residents and businesses can recycle unwanted electronic items 3-7 p.m. Wednesday at Lake Michigan College's South Haven Campus, 125 Veterans Blvd., South Haven.

Green Earth Electronics Recycling of St. Joseph will operate the event.

Accepted items include computers, laptops, monitors, televisions, telephones, cameras, DVD players, cords and cables, printers, toner cartridges, cell phones, refrigerators, air conditioners, appliances and any other electronic item with a cord.

A \$5 hazardous waste fee will be collected for CRT monitors and a \$10 fee for tube televisions. All other items are recycled free of charge. All hard drives will be wiped to Department of Defense specifications or shredded.

Rebate incentives will be offered to customers of a participating utility provider (Indiana Michigan Power, South Haven Public Works and Dowagiac Electric) who recycle working refrigerators, freezers, dehumidifiers or room air conditioners. Rebates are \$50 for refrigerators and freezers, and \$15 for dehumidifi-

ers and room air conditioning units.

Customer information will be collected at the event, and rebates will be mailed after information is submitted and processed. To qualify for a rebate, customers will need to have their account number or a copy of their utility bill at the time of appliance drop-off.
