

LMC open house is April 26; dorm will be featured

— Lake Michigan College is hosting an open house from 11 a.m.-1 p.m. April 26 to introduce prospective students and parents to the benefits of living at the college.

A model residence hall suite will be available for viewing. Amenities include a full kitchen, washer and dryer, free Wi-Fi, a 42-inch flat-panel television, furniture,

free utilities, and access control to the suites and individual bedrooms.
