Trustees defeated challengers in Tuesday's elections for Lake Michigan and Southwestern Michigan colleges. Terms are for six years.

At SMC, Paul File, Tom Jerdon and Becky Moore won while David Taylor lost in a district that covers Cass County and a portion of Van Buren. The tally: File, 6,522; Jerdon, 6,085; Moore, 7,592; Taylor 5,509.

At LMC, Paul Bergan, Debra Johnson and Mary Jo Tomasini won while Barbara Norman lost. The district covers Berrien County and part of Van Buren. The tally: Bergan, 18,528; Johnson, 22,232; Tomasini, 23,027; Norman, 16,698.
