### LMC men edged by Oakland C.C.

BENTON TOWNSHIP — The Lake Michigan College men's basketball team lost to NJCAA Division II second-ranked Oakland Community College 90-85 on Saturday.

Alec Brown had a team-high 21 points for the Red Hawks (1-1), who led 39-38 at halftime.

Kevin Morse had 20 points for LMC.

Richard Roberts' game-high 25 points paced Oakland (2-0).

### Trujillo leads LMC women in opener

Sabrina Trujillo had 30 points and seven rebounds to lead the Lake Michigan College women's basketball team to an 87-64 victory over Oakland Community College in its season opener on Saturday.

"(Trujillo) really became a very strong player in the second half," LMC coach Jason Cooper said. "She struggled in the first half, maybe first-game jitters, then came out in the second half lighting it up."

Alexis Firovich had 17 points and Nicole Decker scored 10 for LMC. Shalay Stevens contributed eight

points, five rebounds and five assists for the Red Hawks (1-0), who led 35-20 at halftime.

Brijanae Durrrough led Oakland with 26 points.
