LMC women cruise to win over Joliet

Five Lake Michigan College women's players scored in double figures and the Red Hawks coasted to an 86-52 win over Joliet Junior College on Saturday.

Madison Cameron and Shalay Stevens tied for the team lead with 14 points. Sabrina Trujillo, Nicole Decker and Shelby Frederick also scored in double figures.

"We had a great second half that made the score more lopsided," LMC coach Jason Cooper said. "We had equal scoring from our players and shot a lot better in the second half."

The Red Hawks (4-2) and Joliet were tied at 28 at halftime, but out of the break LMC's shots began to fall.

"The perimeter game came around, Sabrina (Trujillo) gave us a spark

off the bench that was huge," Cooper said.
