# LMC sets forum on health care careers

NILES — Lake Michigan College will have a health care career open house from 5-7 p.m. June 2 at its Bertrand Crossing campus, 1905 Foundation Drive, near Niles, LMC reported.

Current and prospective students can learn more about LMC's health care programs, including dental assisting, magnetic resonance imaging and registered nursing. Information on additional health care programs, such as certified nursing assistant, emergency medical technician, medical assisting, and phlebotomy,

will also be available. Attendees can talk with current students and with Dr. Michael Flewelling, practicing dentist and owner of Four Flags Dentistry in Niles.

Flewelling pursued his doctor of dentistry degree after graduating from Lake Michigan College, and has hired several graduates from the college's dental assisting program.

Flewelling will perform oral health screenings as a free public service during the event.

class registration and get help with financial aid, academic advising and assessments. Staff will be on-hand to guide students through the process.

The open house is free and open to the public.

LMC reports that job growth in the health industry is expected to remain strong in Southwest Michigan, and many careers begin with less than one year's training.
